OUR FOUR KEY ACTIONS FOR 2014

1. ADVOCACY FOR AVON'S VISION AND OBJECTIVES WITH PARTICULAR EMPHASIS ON:
 - THE RESTORATION OF NATURAL HABITAT (INCLUDING ENHANCED BIODIVERSITY AND WATER QUALITY) AND
 - THE MULTI-FUNCTIONALITY OF THE RIVER PARK (INCLUDING RECOGNITION OF
 RECREATION, HERITAGE, FOOD PRODUCTION, EDUCATION, ECONOMIC, COMMUNITY MEMORIAL AND OTHER USES).
2. FACILITATE SPATIAL PLAN FOR THE RESIDENTIAL RED ZONE WHICH HAS:
 - THE AGREEMENT OF PROJECT CHAMPIONS BY BRINGING THESE TOGETHER TO DISCUSS AND IDENTIFY
 OPTIONS THAT RESOLVE POTENTIAL CONFLICTS AND COMPETING INTERESTS
 - A MANDATE FROM COMMUNITIES VIA COLLABORATIVE ENGAGEMENT PROCESSES.
3. FACILITATE AND SUPPORT PROFESSIONAL SPECIFICATION OF COMMUNITY PROJECTS
 THAT ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE AVON VISION AND OBJECTIVES.
4. JOINTLY LEAD THE MAHINGA KAI EXEMPLAR PROJECT WITH TE RŪNANGA O NGĀI TAHU
